Measures and Incentives:

I have reviewed the Energy Efficiency Upgrade Summary and Report ("Report") provided by the Complete Energy Solutions Program ("Complete Energy Solutions", "CES" or "Program"), a copy of which is attached to this Agreement. I agree that to the best of my knowledge the schedule of operations contained in the Report accurately describes the hours of operation at the facility listed above. I understand that the energy efficiency, electric vehicle, and Go-Electric measures described in the Report represent an estimate of expected energy savings and/or bill impacts, and that Complete Energy Solutions does not guarantee a specific level of cost savings from the implementation of the proposed energy efficiency measures (collectively, the "Project"). Complete Energy Solutions is administering the Project on the Customer's behalf. Customer agrees to participate in SMUD's Complete Energy Solutions Program provided in partnership with TRC Companies. Incentives for energy savings are calculated using the appropriate baseline to exceed California Title 20 and Title 24 standards.
